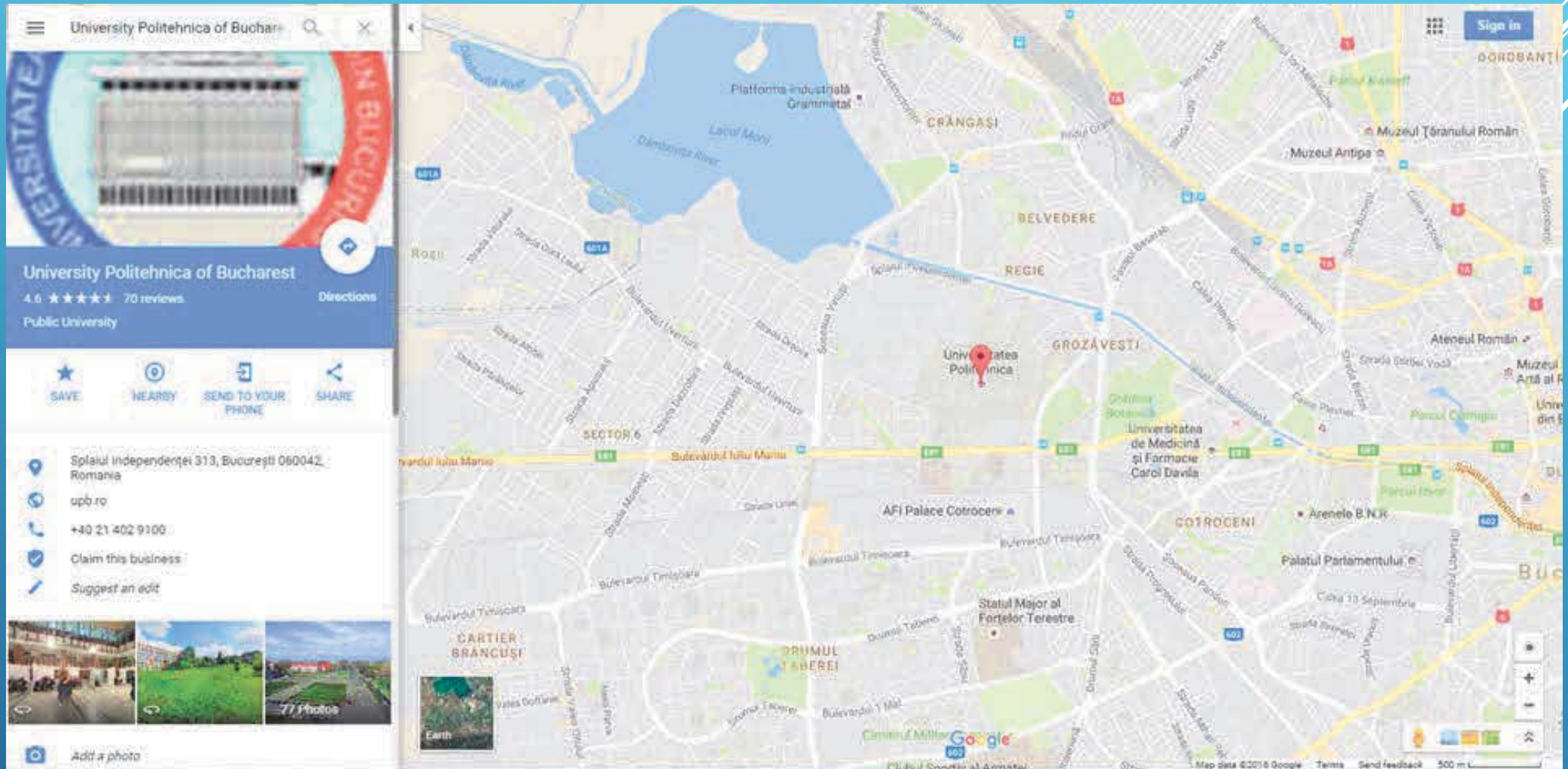
University Politehnica of Bucharest

- Established in 1818
- The largest technical university of Romania
- 15 faculties
- 3 levers of studies: bachelor, master & PhD
- More than 25 000 students
- 3000 members of the permanent staff (about 1500 professors at different levels)



- Institutional collaboration with more than 150 universities from 27 countries from Europe, America, Asia and Africa.

- More than 1 100 000 books and other publications.

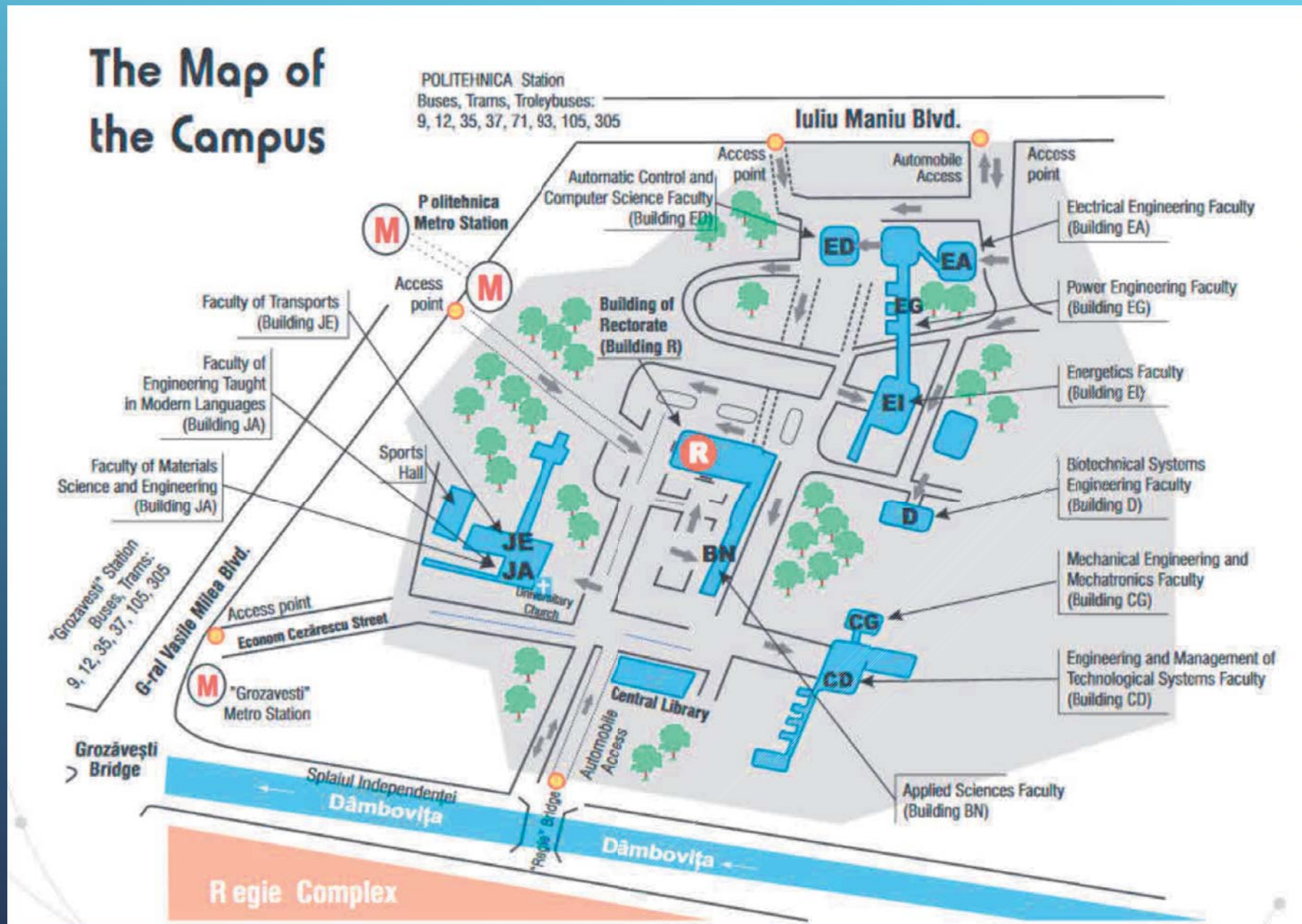


✓ *Facilities*

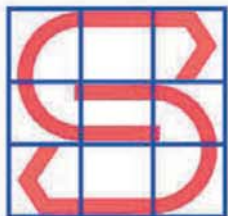

✓ *Examples of costs from previous conferences*

- Romanian currency: Romanian New Leu (RON), 1EUR = 4.65 RON, 1 USD = 4.10 RON
- For Conferences organized in UPB Library the conference rooms rent is free. For other conference places we must rent the space.
- Catering for 200 persons (in UPB Library area): 18000 RON (**4500 USD**), for 4 coffee breaks and 2 lunches (buffet)
- Gala Dinner for 200 persons (Carul cu Bere Restaurant), traditional Romanian menu: 32000 RON (**8000 USD**)
- Conference bag for participants (including proceeding on personalized memory stick, bag with Conference logo, small gift, pencil, town map, printed conference program) **4000 USD** for 200 bags (BlackSeaCom 2015 Conference)
- Potential sponsors: Keysight, Orange Romania, Microsoft, Grayling Romania, Telekom, etc (with values of several thousand dollars each)

✓ *Accommodation in Bucharest.*

- About 1200 hotels and other accommodations. Some relevant examples:
- JW Marriott (5*****) – about 160 EUR/night single room, 200 EUR/night double room
- Radisson Blu (5*****) – about 120 EUR/night single room, 175 EUR/night business room
- Majestic-Ramada (4****) – about 115 EUR/night single room, 127 EUR/night double room
- Novotel Bucharest City Centre Hotel (4****) - about 121 EUR/night single room, 130 EUR/night double room
- Minerva Hotel (4****) - about 55 EUR/night single room, 63 EUR/night double room
- Hotel Central (3**) - about 56 EUR/night single room, 68 EUR/night double room

✓ *Attractions in the city – Romanian Atheneum*



- The first documentary attestation of Bucharest – 20 September 1459 – a document signed by Vlad the Impaler (known also as Vlad Dracula)

- Bucharest is the capital of Romania from 1862.
- With more than 2 million inhabitants, Bucharest is the 6th largest capital from European Union



✓ *Attractions – Palace of Parliament (can see it from the Moon 😊)*



- Parliament building is the second largest building in the world

✓ *Attractions –Royal Palace .*

- In 1840 public transportation started in Bucharest with horse trams
- The Bucharest public transportation company operates the 4th largest network in Europe

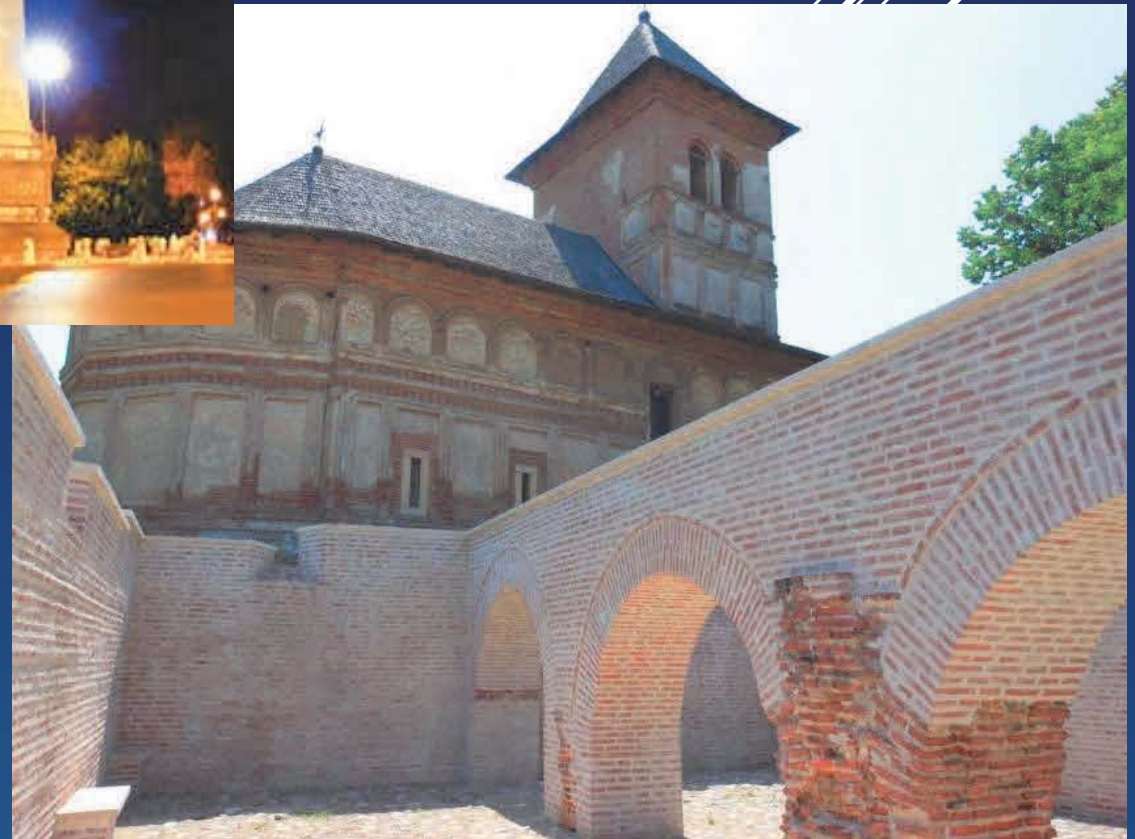


- In 1856 Bucharest was the first city in the world illuminated with lamp oil.

✓ Attractions – Arch of Triumph, Cantacuzino Palace



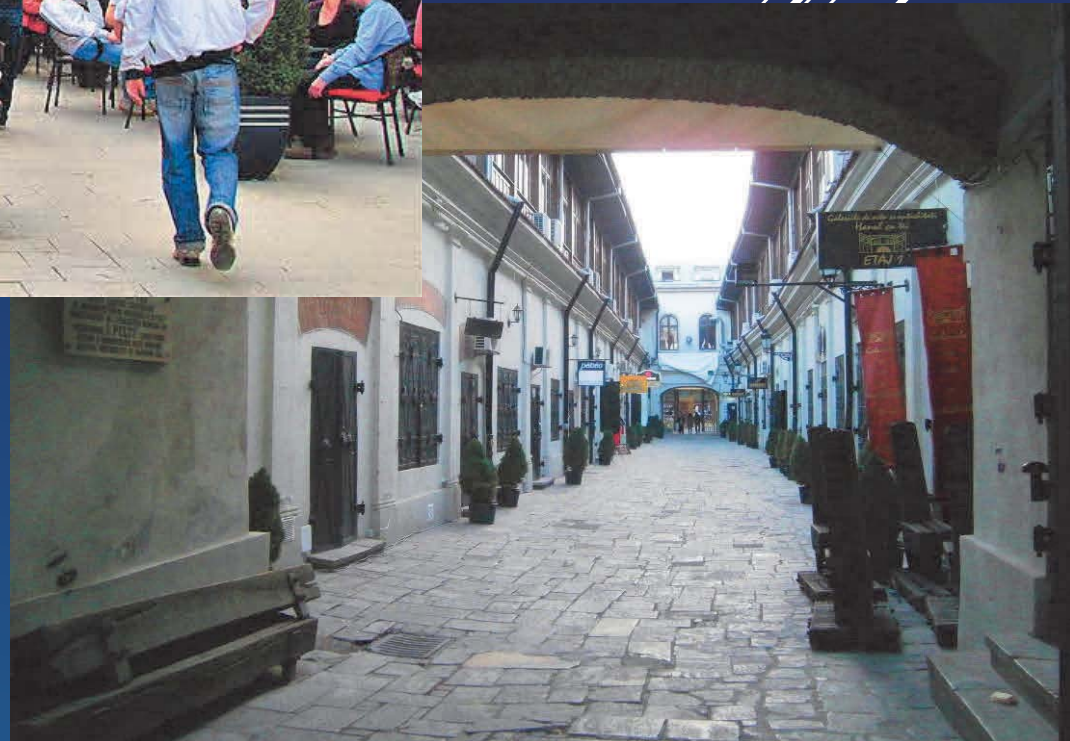
- Due to the green northern area of the town, with large boulevards, Bucharest was once named "Small Paris".

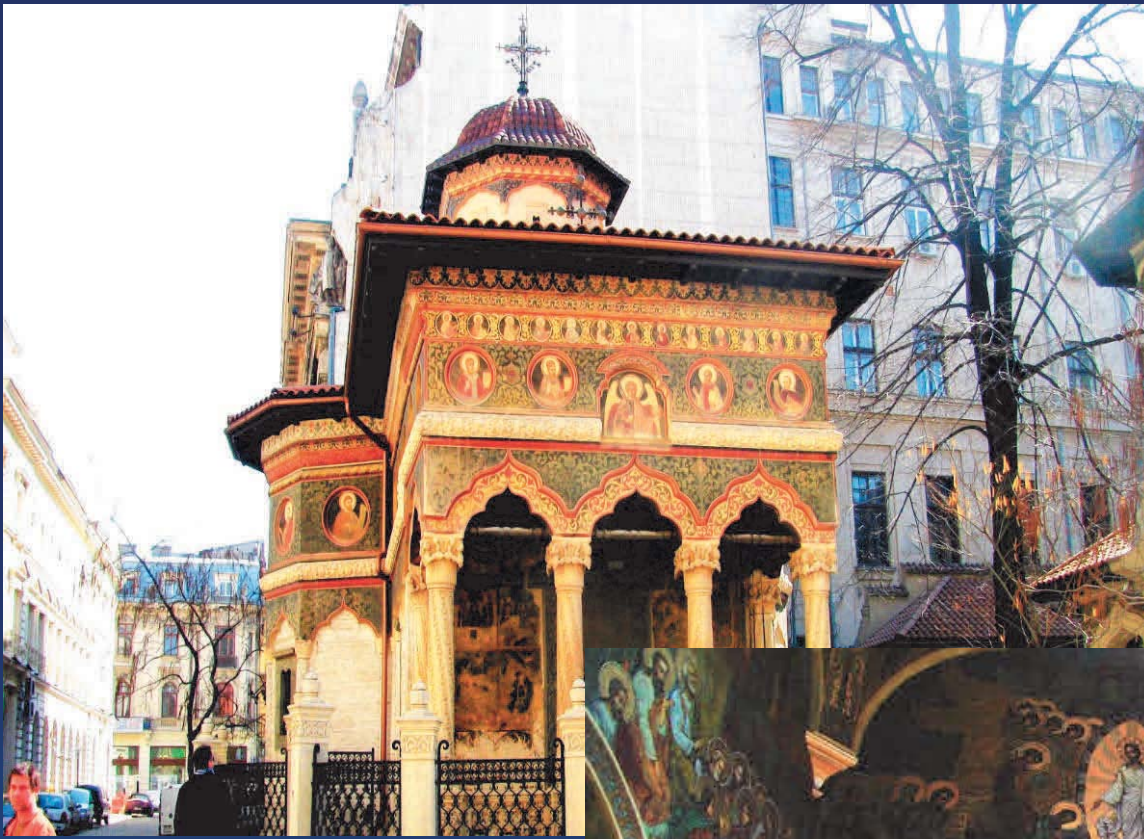


✓ *Attractions – old town.*



- Bucharest has more than 3400 restaurants, bars and coffeeshops (more than 100 located in the Old Town).
