	Comment & Question: Q: Why in only 87% of the final published papers? (Prof. Adachi)
	A: The rest was from special sessions.
	Q: Did you receive any positive or negative opinion on the questionnaire conducted after the WPMC2018? (Prof. Kohno)
	A: No such opinion was found.
	Q: Is there a database for WPMC's site, not from the IEE Xplore site? If you are a WPMC member, I would suggest making it available for download. (Dr. Jha)

# Presentation on WPMC 2020 (Okayama, Japan)

Presentation by Japan (Details on the attached presentation files)

Conference dates October 18 – October /21, 2020

- The venue is the convention center directly connected to Okayama Station. The welcome reception will be at the ANA Crowne Plaza Hotel, and the banquet will be at the Okayama Gran Via Hotel.
- Paper submission deadline: May 11
- Special session request deadline: June 1
- Okayama has sunny weather throughout the year.
- There is also an international airport, accessible by bullet train.
- Expecting participants 100-150

#### Comment:

- There was a question about the positioning of a TPC Co-chair, and it's a role.
- The regional TPC Co-Chair does not seem to be particularly active.
- There is one Co-chair in each of the three different regions, Asia, Europe, and the United States, each of which is responsible for promoting the WPMC. At present, the number of participants has not increased. It seems that we need to make an effort in the future.
- It seems to be related to EDAS, but at the stage of reviewing, there are many reminder emails, and spam filter problems are occurring. It is necessary to manage WPMC's server to avoid the issues.
- Overall, there is too little participation from the industry.
   I think the WPMC subject should be attractive to the industry. If you can appeal to the industry, you can expect to fund, and it is better if you can make more connections with the industry.
- We are worried about the lack of industry participation these days, compared to the early days of the conference.
- I feel that not only the explanation of the technology but also the presentation, such as the business model using it, is attractive. You can invite keynote speakers from the industry, and you can expect platinum support money.
- Regarding the young participants, what about professors and students who have never attended?
   How about inviting them (Prof. Kohno)
- The main focus of the WPMC is on young people. We want to expect participation of local students at Student Awards.

	Comments: Q: A question raised about transportation access from Japan to Sri Lanka.	
	A: Three flights a day from Singapore and Dubai. Sri Lanka Airlines offers direct flights from Narita.	
Convergence on WPMC and GWS	Last year's meeting approved the merger of the two conferences, WPMC and GWS, and signed a contract.	
	The announcement was made. The official name would be 'WPMC,' and the territory would expand to the business industry. A Memorandum of Agreement on Merging WPMC and GWS report was provided to members.	
	Comments:  - Based on the experience of this year's conference, the organizer requires inviting more reviewers for industry business papers (Prof. Velez)	
	Academic and business industry content is different, so it is necessary to understand and proceed for the preparation.	
Guideline's Manual and WPMC website	Since there were some comments/requests at the last year's meeting, an operation manual/guideline was prepared and uploaded to the newly created WPMC-home (wpmc-home.com)	
	All documents will post on the WPMC-home website from now on.	
Omori called for a board member	only meeting. All other candidates left a room.

	The host city is Harning, located in the center of Denmark.  There is also the main campus of Aarhus University, and it is an area that is attracting people as a starting point for future industries.	
	Date proposed to be September 11- September 14, 2022	

- Hosted by Aarhus University, local researchers.
- Easy access for participants. From the international airport Copenhagen by car or several small regional airports.
- We can expect 600 to 800 participants and sponsorships from local companies.

#### Comment:

- Participants from Japan are difficult in mid-September, and a little later is preferred. August is more comfortable to participate. (Prof. Kohno)
- American universities are about to begin their second semester in September.
  - A: The team of Denmark proposes some candidate dates.
- In addition to access, requesting information on whether there is enough accommodation.

A: There are hotels and other types of accommodation (lodges, rental house, etc.)

# Presentation on WPMC 2023 by candidate (Florida, USA)

Presentation by Florida, USA (details on the attached presentation files)

- Candidate cities are Tampa and Orlando.
   Both are attractive for holding conferences. The team wants to get advice from the members of the committee.
- Proposal date is November 27-December 1. One week after Thanksgiving in the United States, participants can avoid traveling congestion.
   The schedule does not overlap with other big conferences.
- From late October to November, Florida has a temperature of about 20 degrees Celsius, a humidity of around 60%, and sunny weather.
- Access is easy, hotels have many selections, and prices are reasonable. Orlando has many hotels as a Disneyland town.
- Florida is famous for the space industry and has many large companies. Research on cybersecurity is also active.
- Orlando is the hub of the space industry and a hot spot. There are office of Amazon Blue Origin (spaceship) and Space X, etc. There is a Tesla office in Tampa.
